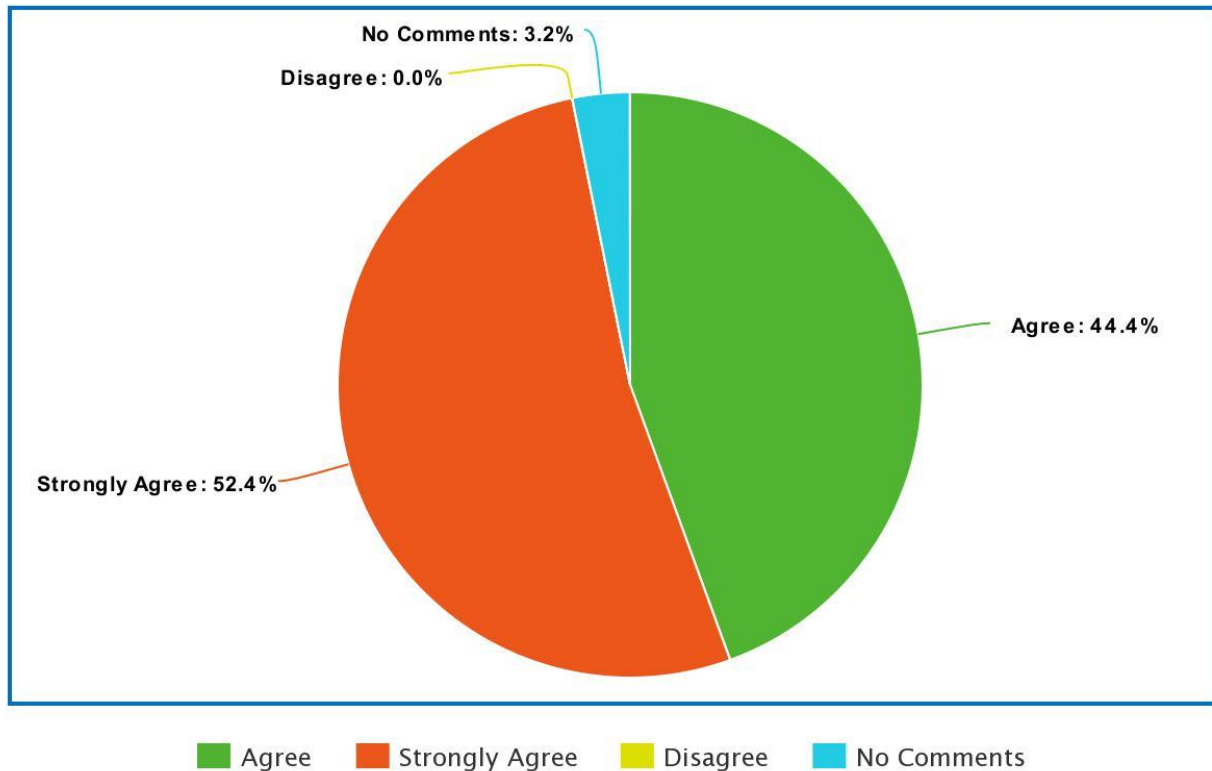

1. Curriculum activities and teacher-student academic bonding in the college are satisfactory

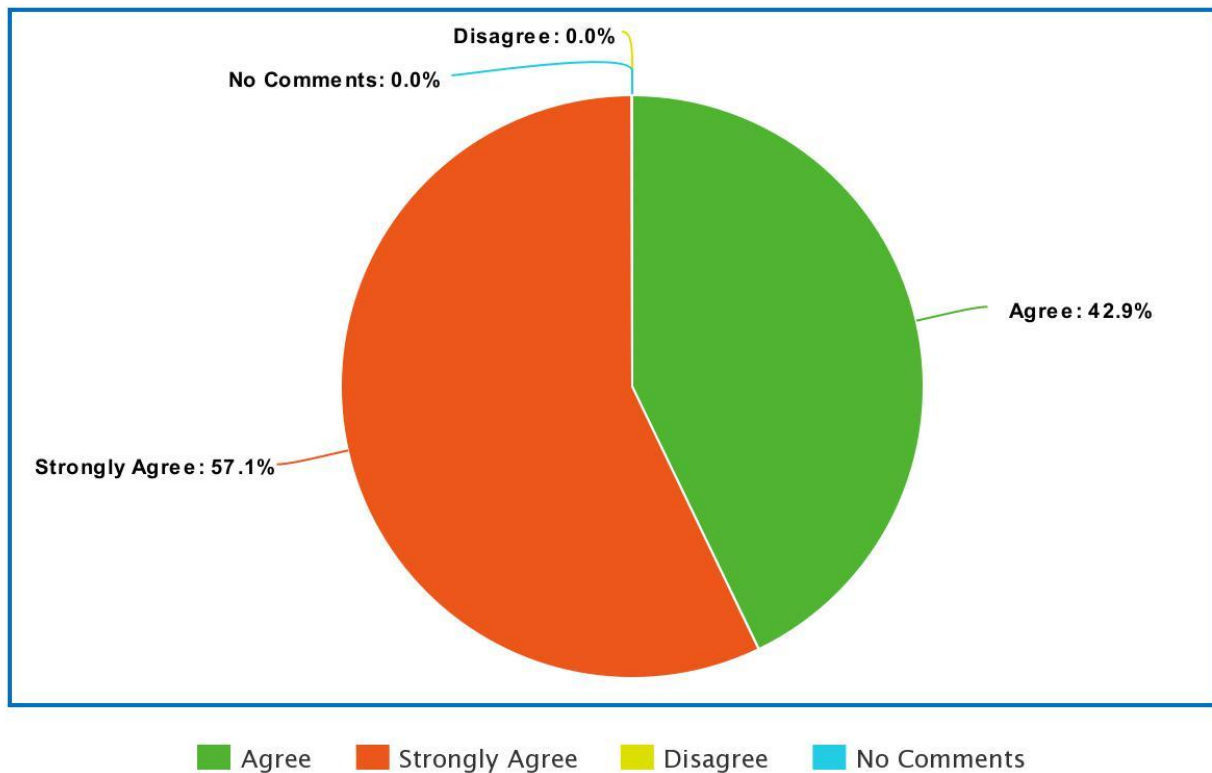

2. Whether there is sufficient number of reference books and e-resources in the college library for the students and staff.

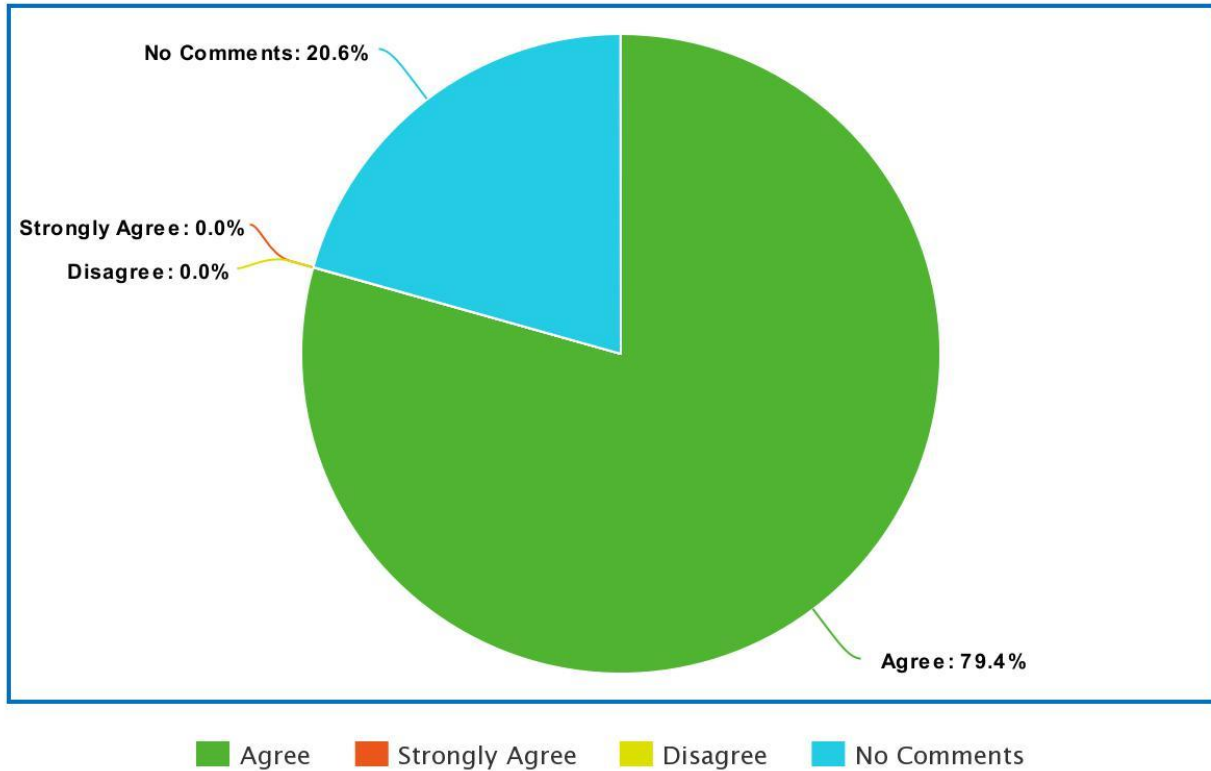

3. Infrastructure facilities in the college are developed upto the satisfactory level.

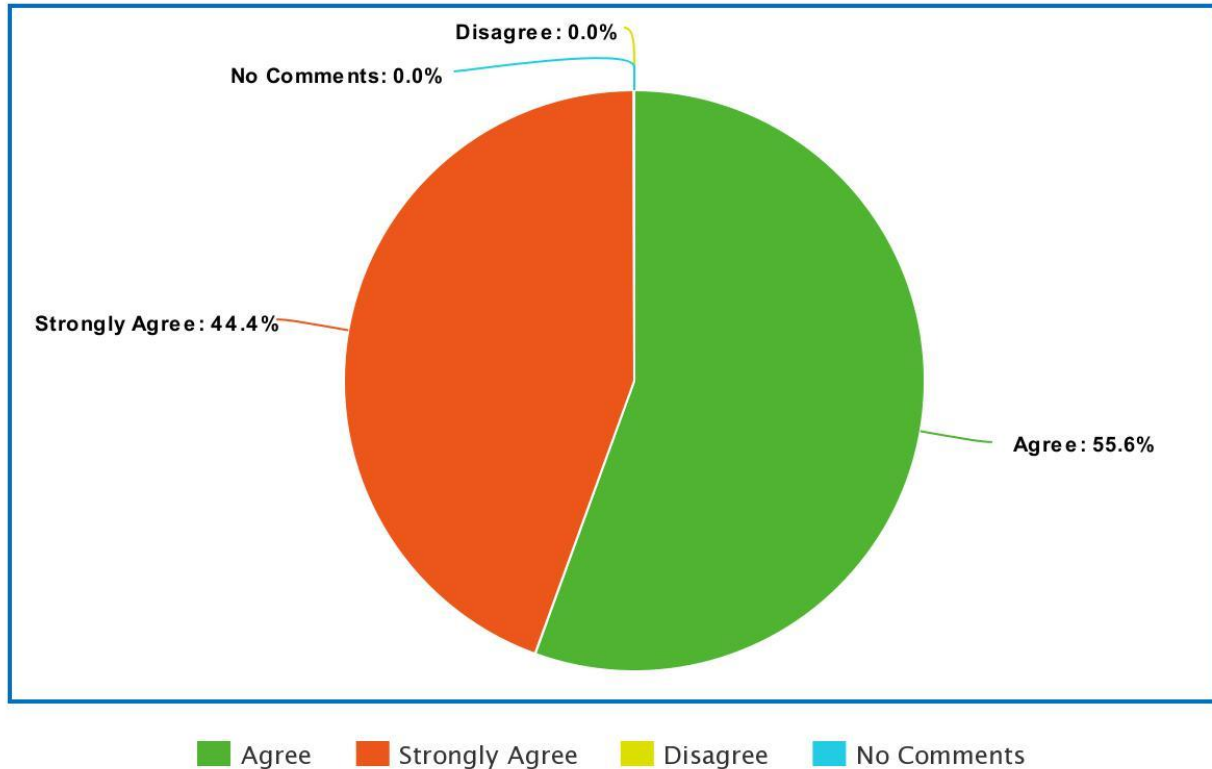

4. Whether evaluation process in the present CBCS curriculum is satisfactory or not.

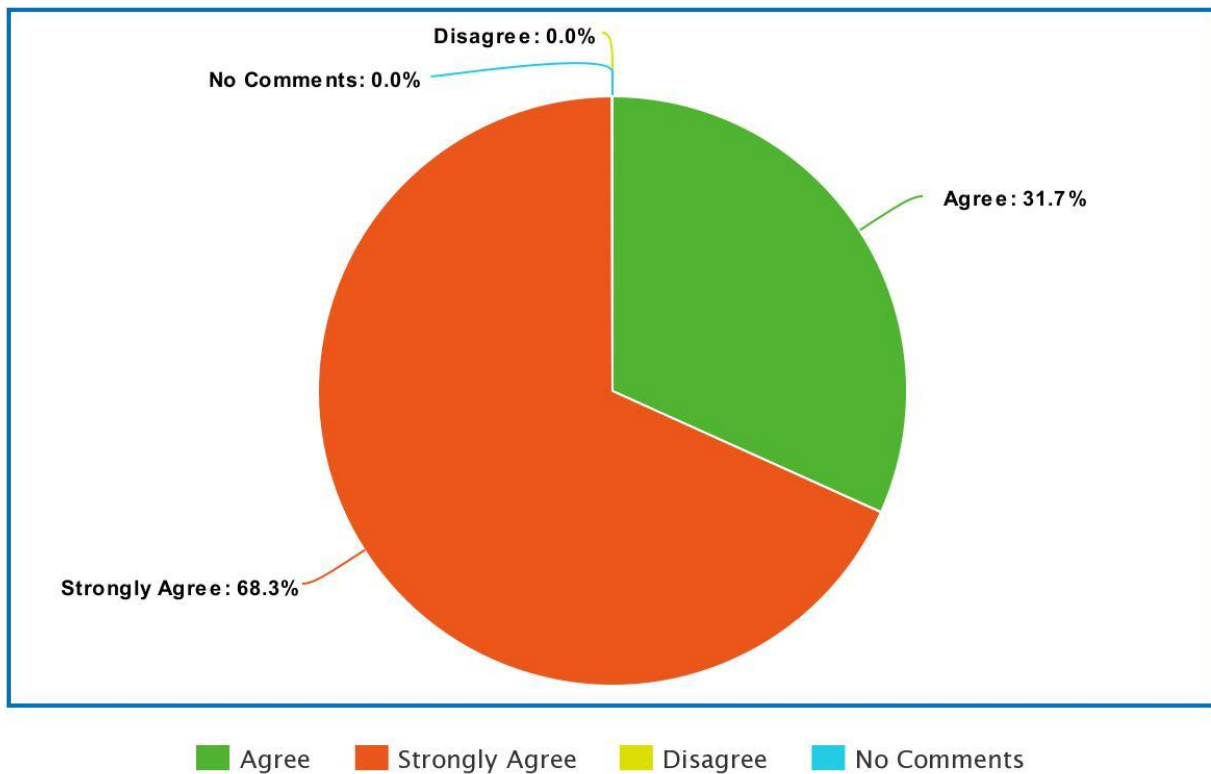

5. Whether the CBCS syllabus running in the college, is helpful for the students to enter into the higher education and finding jobs in different fields.

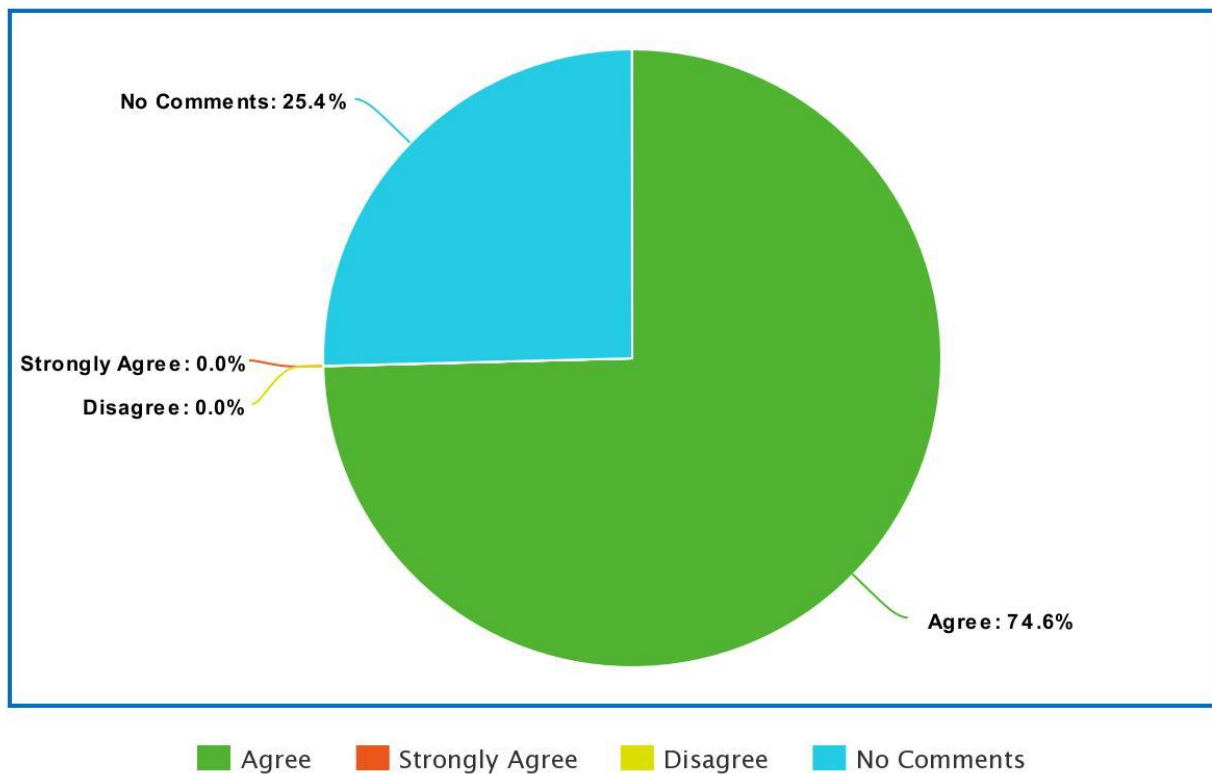

6. The provision of remedial classes for weaker students and tutorial classes for advanced learners help them enormously in acquiring knowledge in accordance with their respective capacities.

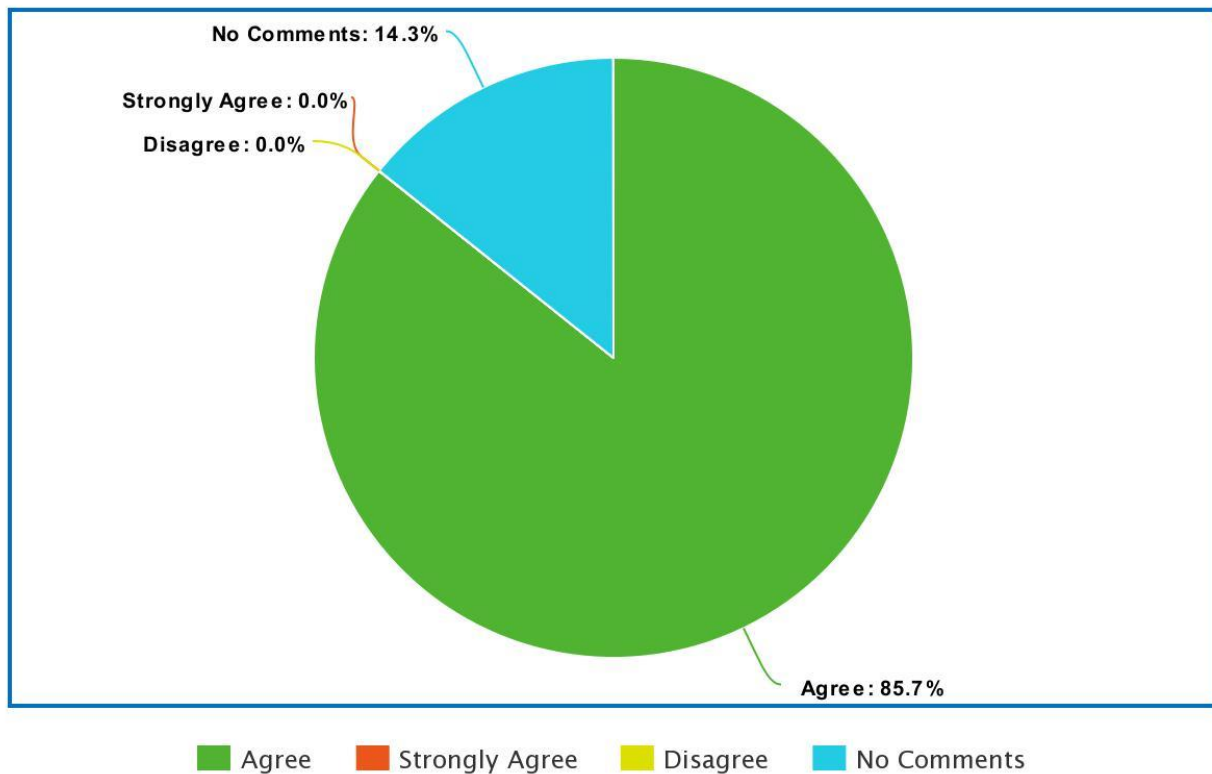

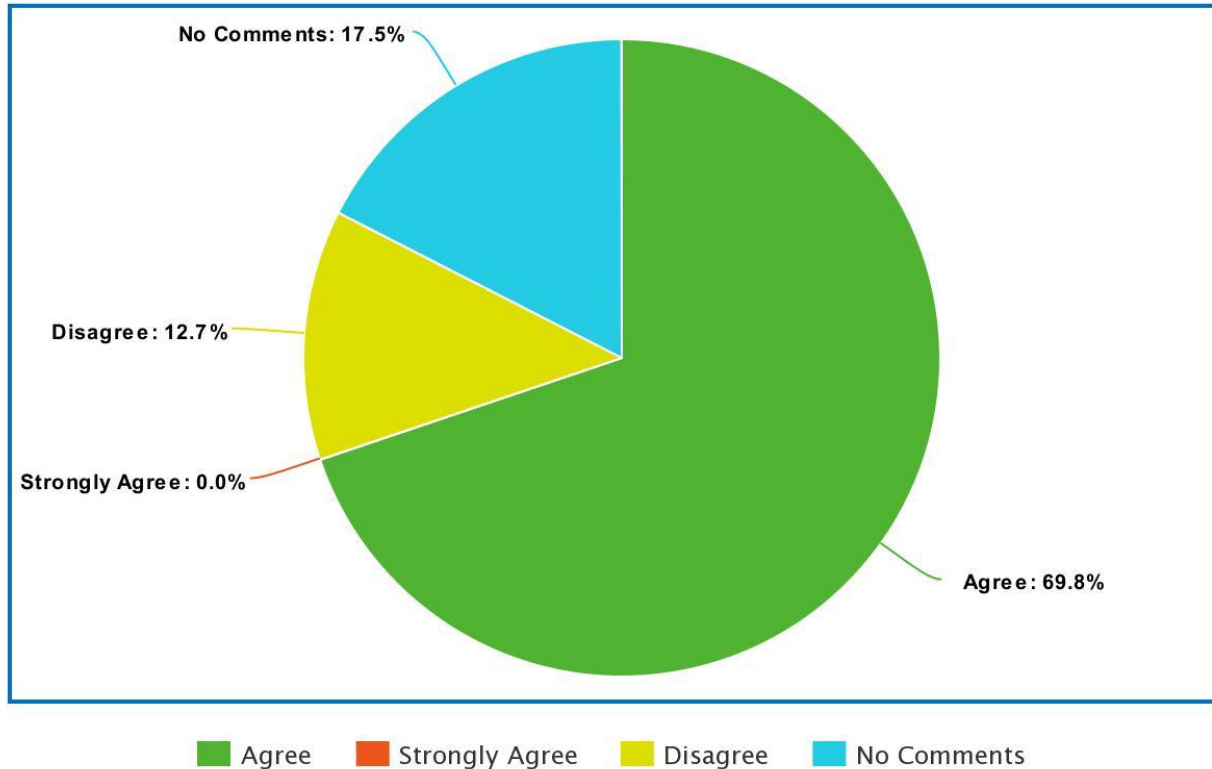
